## About the 2019 Book

"Good Morning, Midnight" is the first novel by Portland author Lily Brooks-Dalton. Augustine, a brilliant, aging astronomer, refuses to abandon the research center in the Arctic when he receives news of a catastrophic event. Soon after, he discovers a mysterious child and realizes that the airwaves have gone silent. They are alone. Meanwhile, Mission Specialist Sullivan and her crew in deep space discover Mission Control is no longer on the air. Both facing an uncertain future, Augustine and Sully's stories gradually intertwine, leading to a profound and unexpected conclusion.


