Seismic Retrofit Bond Measure

The Foundation funded an advocacy campaign to complement the City's informational campaign in support of the November 2017 Library seismic retrofit bond measure. We thank our community for its overwhelming support of the measure and understanding the importance of a strong library to an appealing, vibrant city.

The retrofit project schedule has a few distinct phases:

- By the end of 2018, the City will select a consultant design team, owner's representative, and building contractor.
- This project will require the Salem Public Library to temporarily move to a new location during construction. The City will announce the location in Spring 2019.
- Building construction is scheduled to begin in early 2020 with reopening of the Library in May 2021.
