## **Artist's Statement**

This acrylic-on-canvas piece is inspired by Jade's struggles with her identity. Throughout the story, Jade is trying to figure out who she really is in light of the two cultures she lives in. One factor in this struggle is her appearance, particularly her hair and skin. Using the imagery of flowers in place of her natural hair, I wanted to show Jade could be confidently beautiful. The insecurities are gone and she is laughing, beautiful, and comfortable in her own hair and skin.

I felt an empathetic connection with Jade. She felt she couldn't go to big or too loud with her appearance or voice. With thick, curly hair, I too have struggled trying to fit a standard of beauty and acceptance that was impossible for me for me to achieve. Many people are unaware of this struggle. When painting her portrait, I utilized the element of surprise: flowers for her hair, symbolizing universal beauty.
